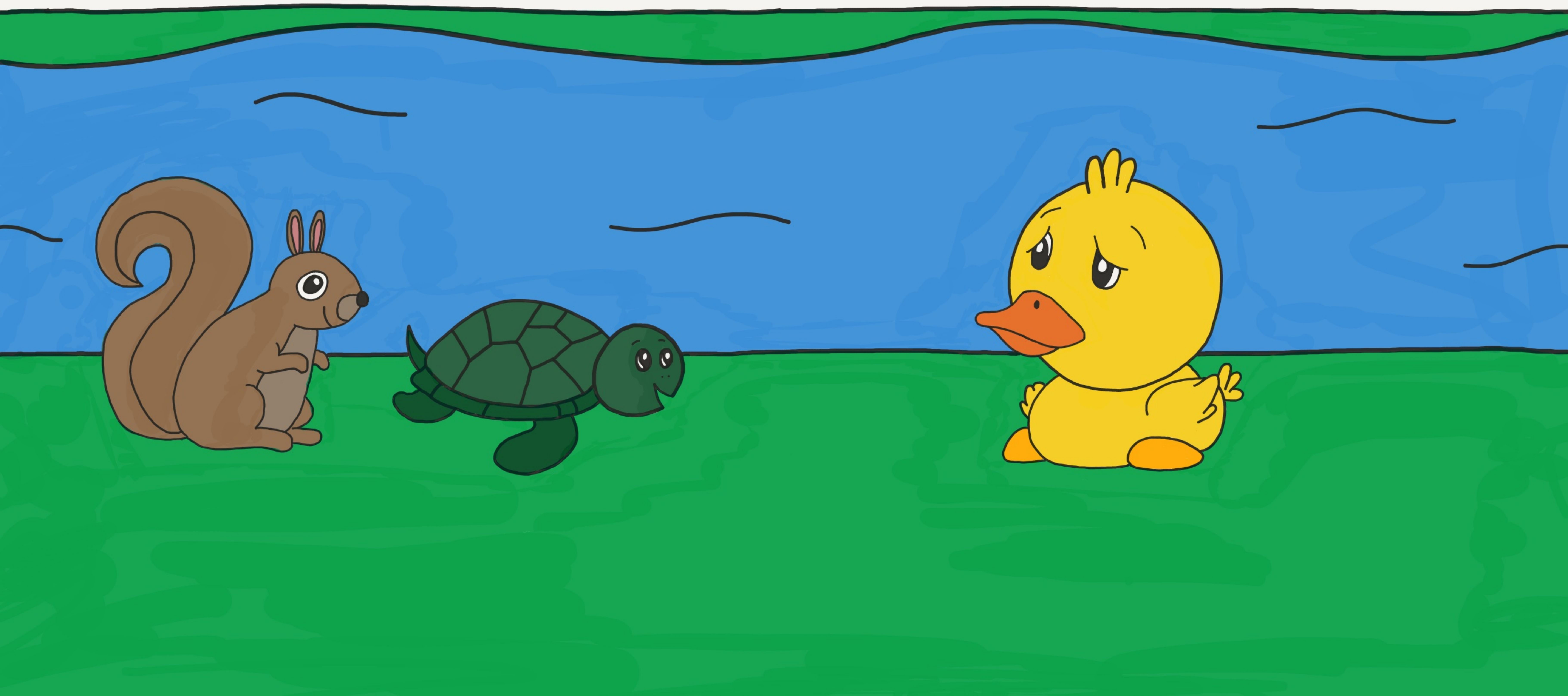
One day, a duckling named Ducky was waddling happily with his family. But suddenly, a big storm appeared. Before Ducky could follow his family to safety, he was swept away.



When the storm began to calm down, Ducky was all alone. He looked for his family, but couldn't find them. Feeling scared, he quacked for help.

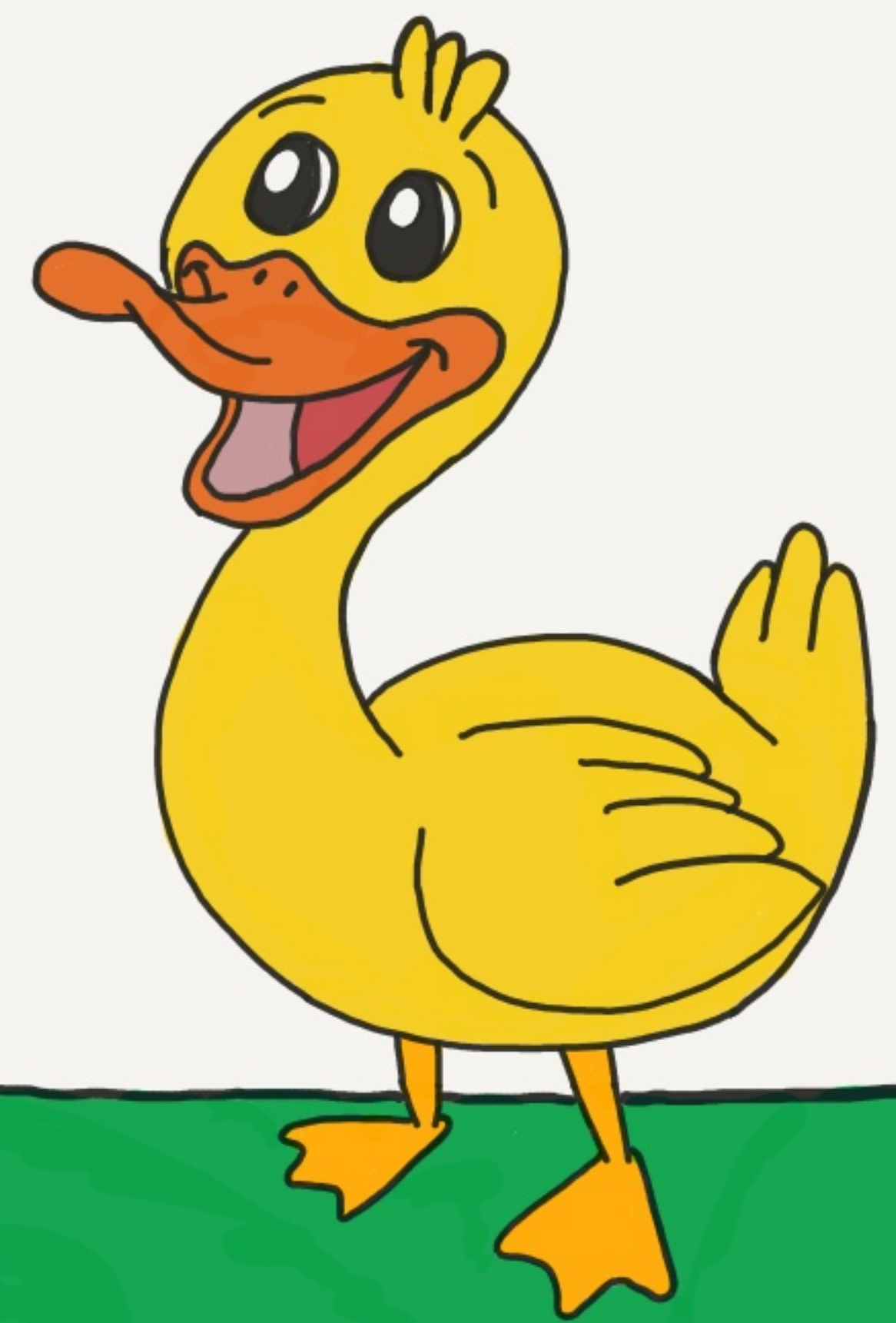
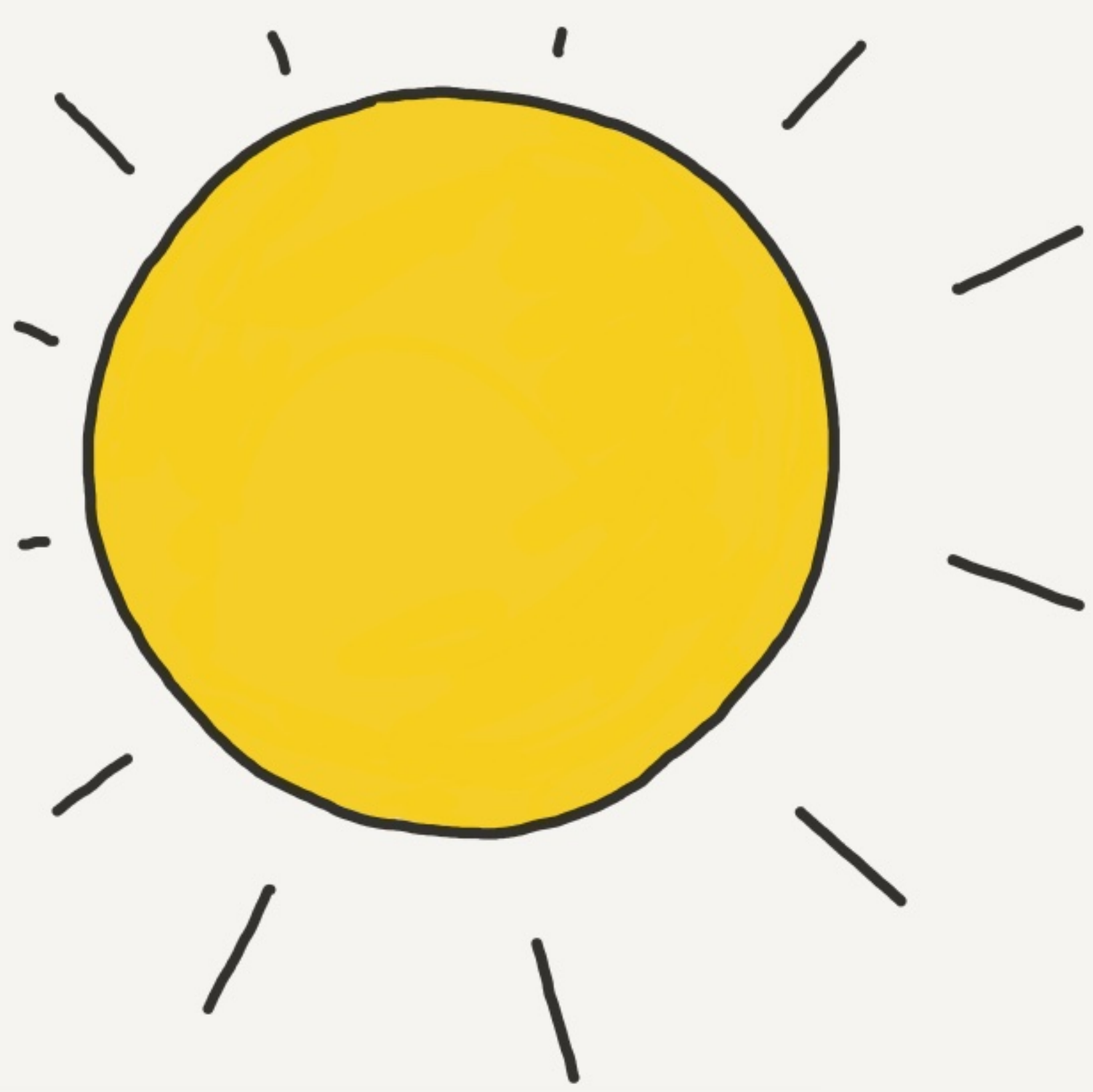


Suddenly, a kind turtle and squirrel appeared and said, "Don't worry, little duck. You're not alone. Come meet our friends."



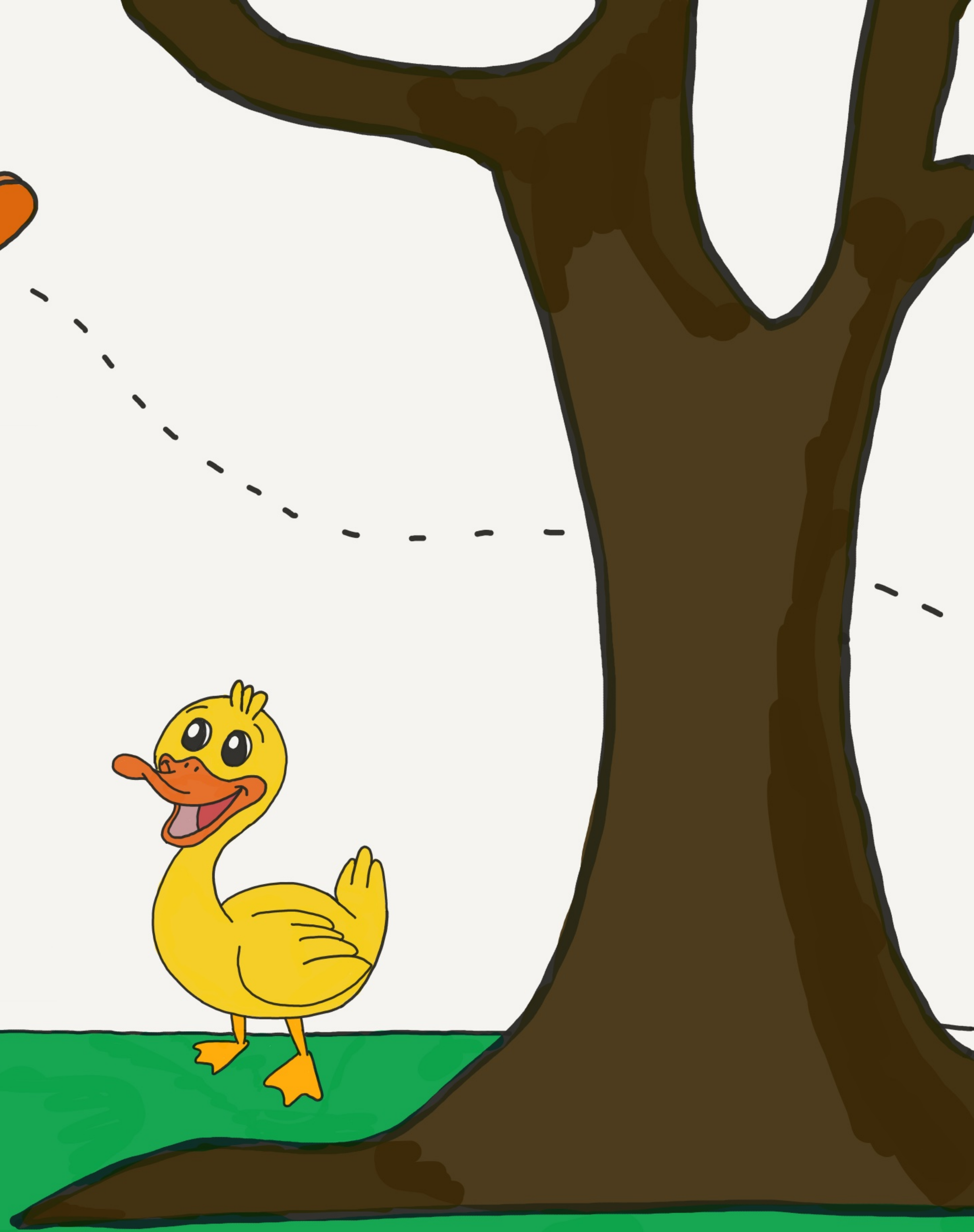


They led Ducky to an iguana and a heron. They both welcomed him warmly. "Stay with us," they said. "We're here for you. We'll be your friends."
